- 4. The bear will not attack if not provoked.
- 5. Both Six and Eight are cylons, but neither of them is important.
- 6. A bass is an instrument, not a fish.
- 7. The witch is wicked only if her skin is green.
- 8. Dorothy will understand Aristotle given she read Plato.
- 9. Neither Harry nor Draco will succeed unless they work together and plan accordingly.
- 10. Sheldon is to the right of Leonard, provided Sheldon sits in his usual spot.
- 11. If you're in the lab, you cannot handle chemicals unless you wear goggles.
- 12. If Sherlock Holmes is real, then he'll take the case if and only if it's interesting.
- 13. The master fights only when he must.
